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TO THE COMMISSIONER OF EDUCATION:

Petitioners submit this Verified Petition in order to challenge the October 15, 2013 and October 30, 2013 votes and resolution of the Panel for Education Policy of the New York City Board of Education approving co-locations within 42 school buildings as set forth in the caption, beginning in the 2014-2015 school year and continuing through the 2016-2017 school year.

Petitioners by their undersigned counsel allege as and for their Verified Petition as follows:

INTRODUCTION

Petitioners

1. Advocates for Justice is a public interest legal foundation which provides and supports legal representation for parents and students throughout the City of New York in matters involving co-locations of schools within the New York City School District. It is located at 225 Broadway, Suite 1902, New York, New York 10007.

2. New York City Parents Union (“NYCPU”) is a New York Not-for-Profit Corporation with members at public schools throughout the City of New York, all of which are under the jurisdiction of the Respondent Board of Education of the City School District of the City of New York. Its business address is 225 Broadway, Suite 1902, New York, New York 10007.

3. Class Size Matters (“CSM”) is a tax-exempt not-for-profit corporation which advocates for smaller class sizes in New York City public schools and in the nation. Its address is 124 Waverly Place, New York, New York 10011.

Respondents

4. Respondent New York City Board of Education (the “BOE”) is the School Board, as that term is defined in the Education Law for the New York City School District. The Panel for Education Policy (“PEP”) is the policy-making body for the BOE. The central office for the BOE is located at 52 Chambers Street, New York, New York 10007.

5. Respondents American Dream Charter School, Success Academy Charter School – New York 2, Mott Hall Charter School, Icahn Charter School 1, Icahn Charter School 2, Icahn Charter School 3, Icahn Charter School 4, Icahn Charter School 5, Icahn Charter School 6, Icahn Charter School 7, Success Academy Charter School – Crown Heights, Uncommon Charter High School 3, Invictus Preparatory Charter School, Success Academy Charter School – New York 3, Success Academy Charter School – New York 4, Success Academy Charter School – New York 1, Success Academy Charter School – Hell’s Kitchen, New School Success Academy Charter School – Manhattan Middle School, Success Academy Charter School – Harlem 4, The Lexington Academy, DREAM Charter School, New York Center for Autism Charter School, Girls Preparatory Charter School of the Bronx, Children’s Aid College Prep Charter School, Compass Charter School, Explore Exceed Charter School, Coney Island Preparatory Public Charter School, Achievement First North Brooklyn Preparatory Charter School, Success Academy Charter School – New York 5, and Success Academy Charter School – New York 6, are Charter Schools chartered under the NY Education Law or Charter Schools in formation, which have not yet been chartered.

FACTS

6. Between August 29, 2013 and September 30, 2013, Respondent Board of Education issued Education Impact Statements (“EISs”) describing co-locations of various

schools in at least 42 separate school buildings. Some of the schools being co-located were public schools, some were charter schools. These EISs are published on the BOE's website and are incorporated by references as Exhibit A.

7. In late September and early October the BOE held public hearings in all 42 locations and in several others where there was going to be significant changes in school utilization.

8. On October 15, 2013 and October 30, 2013, the Panel on Educational Policy conducted public meetings (see Exhibits A and B) and voted to approve all 42 of the co-locations described in the caption above.

9. a. All of the EISs described in Paragraph 4 were boilerplate, pro-forma documents, not prepared in accordance with the requirements of Education Law 2590(h)(2-a), which did little or no actual analysis of the proposed co-locations. Most importantly, no analysis was done concerning the impact on programs for students with educational disabilities and those who are English language learners.

b. Upon information and belief, no PEP member read the transcripts of the public hearings or gave anything other than cursory attention to the EIS.

c. The PEP and other staff did no independent analysis of the 42 co-locations.

d. In many cases, the schools being approved for co-location did not even have charters.

10. By acting as aforescribed, the PEP and therefore the DOE proceeded in a manner violative of the Education Law, including but not limited to Section 2853, and in a manner which was arbitrary and capricious, before approving the co-locations. They did not

consider the input of the affected communities, they did not do a reasoned analysis of the impact of each co-location, whether it be on existing student populations or on students who had special education needs or who were English language learners; there was no rational consideration or discussion of the proposals by PEP, even though there was considerable parent and elected official publicity opposing each proposal.

PRAYER FOR RELIEF

WHEREFORE, petitioners pray that the Commissioner:

1. Enter an order enjoining the BOE from proceeding with the co-locations approved on October 15, 2013 and October 30, 2013.
2. Award Petitioners costs and attorneys' fees.
